



GTT notified by Samsung Heavy Industries for the tank design of a new LNG carrier for Navigare

Paris – February 18th, 2019. GTT has received an order from the Korean shipyard Samsung Heavy Industries (SHI) for the tank design of a new 174,000 m³ LNG carrier (LNGC), on behalf of the Danish ship-owner Navigare.

The tanks of this unit will be fitted with the <u>Mark III Flex</u> membrane containment system. The vessel's delivery is scheduled during the first half of 2021.

Philippe Berterottière, Chairman and CEO of GTT, declared: "We are pleased to be entrusted by our partner of excellence SHI to accompany the ship-owner Navigare in its entry into the LNG world on its first LNGC project".
